CHRISTMAS LUNCHEON

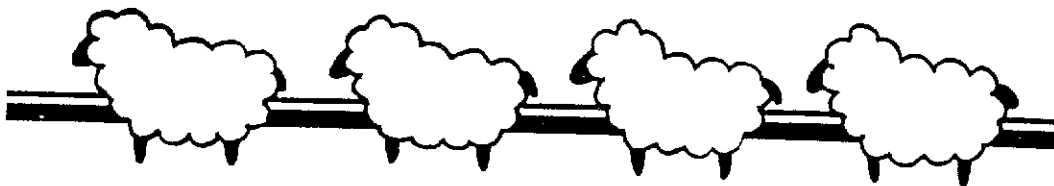

NOVEMBER PROGRAM

Besides the election of officer for 1997, we will have the doll workshop, and yarn sale. Materials to bring are:

- Double pointed or straight needles, size 7 or 8
- Odd bits of knittting worsted weight yarn
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors and crochet hook

Stitch-of-the-month - Remember...6 inches square...a 10 inch tail at each end for sewing.

This month's stitch is the two color check pattern.

Six Inch Squares for Afghan

Material: Acrylic worsted yarn - Multiple of 2 sts + selvedge
Size 7 needles

Cast on 32 sts

Knit 2 rows (color A)

Row 1 - (color A) K 2, *slip 1, K 1* to last 2 stitches, K 2.

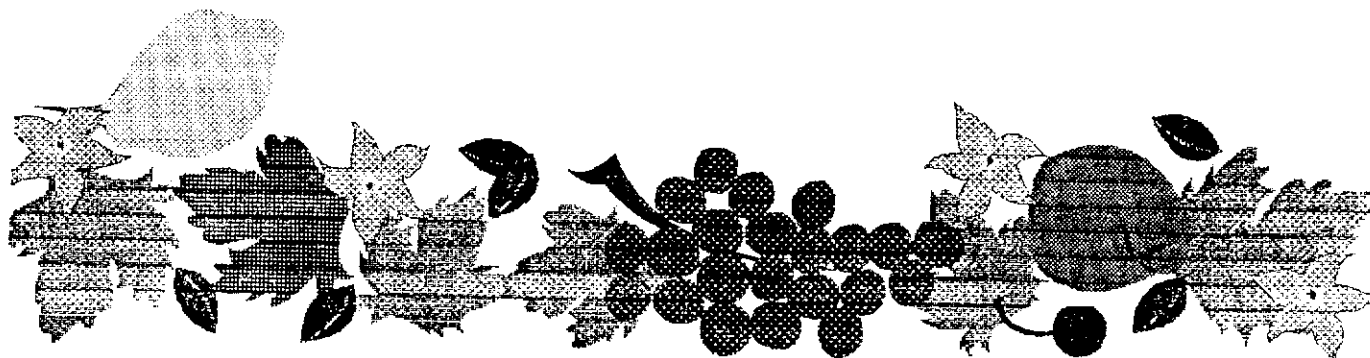
Row 2 - (color A) K 2, P 28, K 2

Row 3 - (color B) K 2, * K 1, slip 1* to last 2 stitches, K 2

Row 4 - (color B) K 2, P 28, K 2

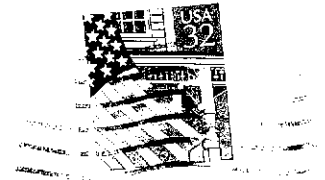
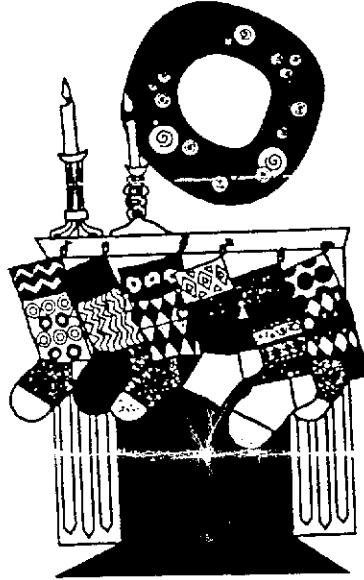
Repeat rows 1 - 4, till 2 rows short of 6".

Knit 2 rows



DOLL PATTERN

Cast on 30 stitches. If using double pointed needles, knit in rounds.
 Work 6" in stripes.
 Change to face color
 Knit 2"
 Knit 1, K2 tog for 1 round
 Knit 1 round
 Knit 2 tog for 1 round
 Knit 1 round
 Knit 2 tog and draw thread through remaining stitches
