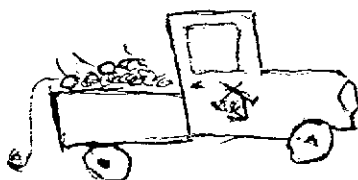
Helga offers some very creative, high fashion original designs. She caters to a diverse group of clients in the international community, and carries many imports.

BEAR PATTERN

Size 10 needles, 4 ply knitting worsted using 2 colors. Cast on 30 stitches in BEAR COLOR

Knit in garter stitch 10 ridges

Knit in stockinette stitch in MAIN color 5 rows

Knit in garter stitch 10 ridges

LEGS: Put 15 stitches on stitch holder

1st leg: Knit in garter stitch 15 rows (8 ridges)

Add 2 rows of BEAR COLOR, cast off

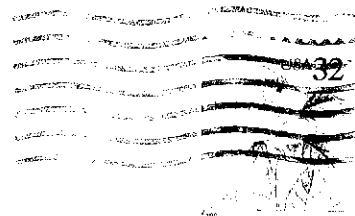
2nd leg: Pick up 15 stitches from holder and finish as other leg

Arms: make 2

Cast on 10 stitches in MAIN color

Knit 9 rows, finish in 2 rows BEAR color --- cast off

Sew up bear and stuff. Pinch and sew head for 2 ears, embroider eyes, etc. Sew up and stuff arms and attach to body.
