Several people asked about the stitch pattern in the sleeve of the jackets worn by Ann Dumanis and Flora Young. Therefore we have used the pattern for our Stitch-of-the-month.

Stitch-of-the-month

This stitch looks entirely different when Row 2 is started with Purl 1 instead of Purl 2. Try it both ways.

Cast on 33 stitches. Knit 2 rows.

Row 1 - K 2, K1, *with right hand needle behind, knit the second stitch through the back loop, Knit first stitch*. Repeat * to * till 2 stitches remain, K2.

Row 2 - K2, P2, *Purl 2 nd stitch, Purl 1st stitch* to last 3 stitches, Purl 1, Knit 2

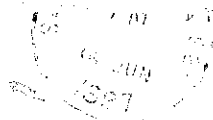
or

Cast on 33 stitches. Knit 2 rows.

Row 1 - K2, K1, *with right hand needle behind, knit the second stitch through the back loop. Knit first stitch *. Repeat * to * Till 2 stitches remain, K2.

Row 2 - K2, P1, *Purl 2 nd stitch, Purl 1st stitch *, repeat to last 3 stitches, Purl 2, Knit 2,

As requested, the June meeting will be a Knit-In.
